On behalf of the Council on Education for Public Health, I am pleased to advise you that the CEPH Board of Councilors acted at its December 15-16, 2019 meeting to accredit the Public Health Program at California Baptist University - Online for a five-year term, extending to December 31, 2024, with an interim report due in fall 2020. The interim report will address data collection from alumni and employers.

We are attaching a copy of the Council's final accreditation report. This differs from the team's report that you received prior to our meeting in several areas:

- The Council added language to Criteria A1 (Organization & Administrative Processes), B3 (Post-Graduation Outcomes), B4 (Alumni Perceptions), D5 (Applied Practice Experiences), F1 (Community Involvement), and G1 (Diversity) acknowledging the program's response.
- The Council changed the finding for Criteria D2 (Foundational Competencies) and D4 (Concentration Competencies) from partially met to met and added language explaining its rationale.

We appreciated the many courtesies extended to the site visit team during its visit.
